MRI OF THE LUMBAR SPINE

This study was performed on a Phillips Magnetic Resonance Imaging system with field strength of 1.5 Tesla.

Technique:

1. Sagittal T1-weighted sequence
2. Sagittal T2-weighted sequence
3. Sagittal STIR sequence
4. Transaxial T1-weighted sequence
5. Transaxial T2-weighted sequence

Clinical History:

This patient was injured at work and complains of low back pain.

Findings:

There are no compression fractures or destructive changes. Bone marrow within visualized bony structures demonstrates relatively normal signal intensities. Conus medullaris is at T11-T12 level and does not demonstrate any enlargements or distortions.

L1-L2: The posterior and posterolateral disk/endplate configuration appears to be normal. The neural foramina and subarticular gutters appear to be intact.

L2-L3: The posterior and posterolateral disk/endplate configuration appears to be normal. The neural foramina and subarticular gutters appear to be intact.

L3-L4: The posterior and posterolateral disk/endplate configuration appears to be normal. The neural foramina and subarticular gutters appear to be intact.

L4-L5: The posterior and posterolateral disk/endplate configuration appears to be normal. The neural foramina and subarticular gutters appear to be intact.

L5-S1: There is a broad-based asymmetric posterior disk protrusion, which at its maximum on the right side measures about 3mm and indents the thecal sac. There is no evidence of central or foraminal stenosis.

Conclusion:

1. There is a broad-based asymmetric posterior disk protrusion at L5-S1 level, which at its maximum on the right side measures about 3mm and indents the thecal sac.
2. Incidentally, part of a cystic mass is noted high in the left side of the pelvis. To further evaluate, a pelvic ultrasound is recommended.
